Reading at home

It is important for children's language development for them to hear stories and books each day. We read to your children every day in school, and it is important that books are also shared at home. We will be having library time on a Friday. Please ensure you return the books each Friday.

Possible discussions to have with your child whilst reading/ after reading

- What was the story about?
- What was your favourite part?
- What can you see on this page?

Its also good to discuss the front cover, author, and illustrator.

Labelling

Please ensure ALL items of clothing and equipment are named including shoes, lunchboxes, and water bottles.

Coats

Please ensure all children bring in a coat every day as it can be chilly in the mornings.

PE

We will be doing some PE sessions outside. Please ensure children have labelled plimsoles or trainers. It's important that all children have a PE kit to change into, we encourage the children to change as independently as possible.

Summer

Please make sure your child has applied suncream before they come to school. If you are providing suncream for us to apply at lunchtime, please make sure this is named. Please provide a named sun hat, to remain in nursery.

We will continue to use 'evidence me' to send home key moments from your child's learning in school as well as some information about learning for you to discuss with your child. Do use 'evidence me' to let us know any information from home; this could be a visit you have done from home, a piece of learning from home or anything else that you feel we would enjoy hearing about.
